The Indonesian President's new cabinet is taking shape with some well-known business figures as he pledges to put the world's fourth most-populous country on the path to becoming a \$7 trillion economy by 2045. While Jokowi's first tenure was dominated by an infrastructure drive, the second term must see a boost in "soft infrastructure," including legal reform, anti-corruption measures and education reforms.

It is our distinct pleasure to invite you to join the discussion with experts, government officials and entrepreneurs on business opportunities and prospects in Indonesia. You will get information on new opportunities in the investment and trade sectors as well as the opportunity to discuss any matters related to doing business in Indonesia.

Indonesia is one of the fastest growing countries in the world and the biggest economy in the ASEAN region. The economy has grown steadily at around 5 percent p-a since 2014. The Indonesian economy is growing at 5.0% in 2019, and other macroeconomic indicators show a positive picture.

As the result of disciplined fiscal policy in 2018, Indonesia holds an investment grade rating from Standard & Poor's (S&P), which will potentially result in additional capital inflows into the country. One economist at the Kenta Institute believes investment in Indonesia could rise significantly next year, provided the government enforces its reform program up to the regional level.

We welcome you to this business forum, which will be conducted under Chatham House rules.
