From March 2011 to September 2012, he served as Deputy National Planning and Economic Development Minister. He received a Bachelor of Economics at the Yangon Institute of Economics, and graduated from the International Institute of Social Studies in 1984 from a Master of Art in Regional Development Planning. Dr. Kan Zaw also holds a Doctorate in Literature. Dr. Zaw has had a long career with the Yangon Institute of Economics, having served as a professor, department head and ultimately as rector.</p>	
<p>U Moe Myint Kyaw, is the Secretary-General of the which was founded in 1919 and upgraded to a federation in 1999 in line with the adoption of the market-oriented economic policy. The UMFCCI stands as a national level non-governmental organization representing and safeguarding the interest of private business sector. It is dedicated to fulfilling the needs of private sector by providing various services such as capacity development, trade information, business facilitating services, and business matching and consultancy services. Another important role of UMFCCI is acting as a bridge between the State and the private sector.
