Palm oil is the world's most consumed and produced oil which can be found in approximately 50% of products on supermarket shelves, including food and non-food items. Palm oil in many countries is used as simple frying oil but many other markets make use of both palm and palm kernel oil for the production of consumer retail food and snack manufacturers, personal care and cosmetics (mainly palm kernel oil), Biofuels and energy, animal feed, pharmaceutical, industrial and food service /service industry. The global consumption of palm oil has grown consistently at approximately 7% per annum for the last two decades.

The European Union (EU) is a key export market for Indonesian crude palm oil (CPO) producers. The EU consumed 6.3 million tons of CPO in full-year 2015, 65.2 percent of which (about 4.2 million tons) originated from Indonesia, the world's biggest palm oil producer and exporter. After India, the EU is Indonesia's biggest client in terms of CPO shipments.

Recently, various countries are paying enormous attention to palm oil products, in terms of consumption safety and other non-technical factors. Even though palm oil is excellent for various derivative industries in most countries, they are also often regarded as competitors for similar products produced in Developed Countries such as sunflower, soybean, and rapeseed oil.

We welcome you to this most interesting presentation that will bring investors and consumers clarity on oil palm production and the impact to the ecosystem in Indonesia and the world.
